## 词语链接

### 1. **outside**

#### 【例句】


1. We can't eat in the classroom, but we can eat *outside*.

2. Mike is sitting *outside* the house.

① 作副词，意为“在外面，向外面”，常单独作状语。如：

Please don't look outside.

Look at the blackboard.



② 作介词，意为“在.....的外面”，后跟表示地点或处所的名词。如：

**They often take a walk outside the school.**



2. OK, so we **must** be on time.

对的，所以我们必须守时。

1) **must** 作为情态动词，表示“必须”、“  
“务  
必”，有时还表示“一定”，起到加强  
语

气的作用。如：

You **must** come tomorrow.

你(们)明天必须来。

She **must** have this dictionary.

2) **on time**是一个固定介词短语，表示“按时；准时”。如：

**We must get to school on time.**

我们必须按时到校。

**Planes and trains don't always arrive on time.**

火车、飞机并不总是准点到达。

3) 系动词**be**与形容词或介词短语联用，是英语一种常见的语句结构，表示某种

**be quiet** 保持安静； **be strict** 要求严格  
**be on time** 守时； **be at work** 在上班  
这种用法中，动词**be**主要承担着连系句子的语法功能，其后的形容词或介词短语则起着表意的作用。如：

**you mustn't be noisy, children.**

孩子们，你们一定不可喧闹。

**At this time of the day, children are at school.** 一天中的这个时候，孩子们在学校上课呢。

3. **hear, listen**和**sound**都有“听”的意思，但三者是有区别的。

1) **hear** “听说”，侧重于“听”的内容。

I'm sorry to **hear** that you are ill.

听说你生病了，我很难过。

I never **heard** such an interesting story.

我从来没听过这么有趣的一个故事。



2) **listen**“听”侧重于“听”这一动作。

**Listen to** me carefully.

认真听我说。

The children like to **listen to** music. 孩子们喜欢听音乐。

3) **sound**“听起来”,它是系动词,后面接形容词等。

That **sounds** great. 那听起来真不错。

It **sounds** like fun. 听起来挺有趣。

4. **arrive late for** 与 **be late for** 意思相近,  
都表示“迟到”。

**Don't arrive /be late for school.**

上学别迟到。

**I arrived/**was late for** the meeting  
yesterday.**

我昨天开会迟到了。

## 5. 情态动词**have to** 的用法:

意思是“**必须、不得不**”,它侧重于客观上

的必要和外界权威。

1) 结构:**主语 + have to + 动词原形 + 其他**

(一般现在时,主语是第三人称单数时,用**has to**;句子是过去时,用**had to**) 如:



We **have to** wear sneakers for gym class.

在体育课上,我们必须穿运动鞋。

Tom **has to** practice the guitar every day. 汤姆每天必须练习弹吉它。

I **had to** get up at 5:00 am last Monday.

上周一我不得不早上5点起床。



2) 否定形式:主语+**don't have to**+动词原形+其他 (一般现在时,主语是第三人称单数时,用**doesn't have to**; 句子是过去时,用**didn't have to**) 如:

**Nick doesn't have to wear a uniform.**

尼克不必穿制服。

**We didn't have to do our homework at once.**

我们不必马上完成作业。

### 3) 疑问句:

**Do (Does或Did)** + 主语 + **have to** + 动词  
原形 + 其他 如:

**Do you have to** stay at home on  
weekends?

周末你必须呆在家里吗?

**Yes, I do. / No, I don't.**

是的, 我必须。 不, 我不必。

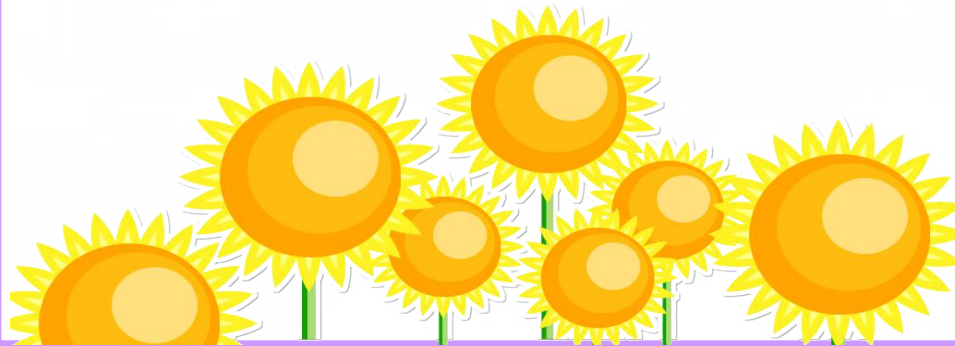
